Yummy in my Tummy: Pumpkin Cheesecake Dip

Ingredients

Two 8oz blocks of softened cream cheese
1 cup Powdered sugar
¼ cup Sugar
¾ cup Pumpkin puree
1 cup Cool Whip softened
1 ½ tsp. Pumpkin pie spice
¼ tsp All spice
¼ tsp. Cinnamon



Directions

1. In a large bowl mix cream cheese with a beater. Add powdered sugar and sugar then beat till fluffy. Fold in pumpkin puree, Cool Whip, pumpkin pie spice, all spice and cinnamon. Stir till smooth.
2. Store in airtight container for 30 minutes
3. Serve with pretzel crisps, Graham crackers, Gingersnaps or apple slices.
